
John 1:12 tells us that to those who recieve the gift of the Son by placing their faith in Him become the Children of God.

Operation Christmas Child-Wilma Collins

Wilma Collins started helping with Operation Christmas Child (OCC) with FSBC as far back as 2005 as a member of another Church called First Baptist Church in La Junta.

First <u>Southern</u> Baptist Church <u>(FSBC)</u> became part of OCC as far back as 2005, exact year is not known by me at this time. <u>In the first year that Wilma volunteered 2005, a total of 220 boxes were filled and sent to the children.</u> For the first couple of years, Wilma was an assistant for Mary Jane Madduxs with FSBC/OCC. Approximately in 2007, Wilma accepted the role as the new OCC Drop Box Leader for the La Junta area. This means... this year is Wilma's 17th year as Drop Box Leader! And about 19 years volunteering for OCC in total! Around 2015/2016, Wilma choose to join the family at FSBC. And we are glad she did!

OCC is a missionary gift giving operation, much bigger than the fun items in each box, the main gift in each box is bringing children around the world together for the Message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. OCC is part of Samaritan's Purse Internaional Relief and OCC was started in 1993.

The Message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ starts as a shoebox to be filled with items of love and fun for the kids. After the shoebox is filled, it is "wrapped in Prayer", and then the GREATEST JOURNEY starts. For every child that receives a "shoebox", it's like receiving a ticket for the GREATEST JOURNEY! The journey is a 12-lesson discipleship course designed for OCC. Children who participate in the program and graduate, learn how to follow Christ and share Him with others. The power of this, is as they share with others, entire families and communities are brought to the power of the Gospel, and new churches are started.

Since 1993 to 2023:

More than 220 million children have received a shoebox in over 170 countries and territories. Since 2009:

40.5 children have enrolled in the 12-lesson program

20.2 million+ have accepted Christ.

1 million + teachers trained.

Volunteers for FSBC/OCC are important! Some of Wilma's go to helpers are Viktoria & Dennis, Diane, Dino, Elizabeth, Arlene, and Tyler. Over the past years, help has come in the form of scout troops, Lion's Club, other churches, as well as many other groups. Wilma welcomes anyone with an interest to assist in this worthy cause. There's no requirement to be a member of a church. Just call the First Southern Baptist Church to learn how to help. Help is welcome in any form, either putting in some hours, making your own boxes or giving a money donations, they all are a great way to help. One essential need for the cash donations, is to help cover the shipping cost for all the shoeboxes to travel to children in other countries.

Wilma is a pro shopper when it comes to finding bargin prices for the goodies in the boxes. Two of her best finds this year where; Eight pencils for .03 cents. And pencil sharpeners at 3.5 cents each! Buying items in bulk can help too.

When does Wilma start collecting items for Christmas 2025? "We have already started collecting," Wilma answers. "Herself and helpers are on the lookout for items year round for our boxes. Some of their finds have already started coming in."

Some items included in this years boxes: combs, dolls, doll clothes, shoes, hats, bracelets, necklaces, balls, paper, coloring books, notebook paper, crayons, pencils, pencil sharpeners, cups, tools, wash cloth, kids clothing, socer ball with air pump, and more.

Last year, 1,402 boxes were collected from within the La Junta area. This year 534 boxes were filled from FSBC alone, and the total collected from the 9 churches/groups throughout southern Colorado for 2024 is 3,984. This is an increase of 2,582 more boxes from the La Junta area then 2023! The boxes are all loaded on the truck and are on their way to share the message of the Gospel to many special childern.

Just a few of the 306 boxes packaged on Nov 10, 2024 at FSBC. In total, over 534 boxes were filled from FSBC for this year's send off.

Sharing the Gospel

How Do I Get Started?

You have accepted Christ as your Savior, now what? We have personal responsibilities as followers of Christ. One of the many responsibilities, is to spread the good news and make disciples of all within our reach.

On Nov 20, 2024, Wednesday Women of Word (WWOW) Bible Study had a special guest speaker about the subject of sharing the Gospel.

Bob Russler, Owner & Operator of Russler Implement of Rocky Ford, Colorado, who is energetic and truly excited to share the Gospel with all. He shared with us his tips for being prepared at a moments notice to share the Gospel.

Some of the tips included: (not the complete list)

- 1. Be prepared-carry with you materials or props that contain Gospel lessons. One handy item is called Gospel Tracts. These are pamphlets that you can leave with a person or at a location for someone to find. When you hand out a Gospel Tract, tell them to be sure to read the last page.
- 2. Keep Fear out of your sharing of the Gospel- It's easy to fear rejection, to feel to shy or not feel that you are ready. But you are "armed with the truth" and "not alone", God is with you.
- 3. Positive Reinforcement- Offering kind words is a great way to open a conversation. Casual conversation will follow, until you heard something from the person that is the perfect time to slide the conversation towards God and Salvation.
- 4. The first few times could be challenging, but keep going, practice will improve your skills.
- 5. Be Bold-Invite people to your church.
- 6. Something to think about- if there was a building on fire, would you sit there and not do anything to save the people inside? No, you would do whatever you can to save them. You are doing what God wants you to do, and that is save his people with the sharing of his Salvation.
- 7. Make yourself available.
- 8. Not all people will be acceptive to receive the Gospel on your first or even your tenth encounter with them. Don't give up, they aren't "ripe" yet. Hopefully, you are helping them to ripen.
- 9. Don't put limits on God.
- 10. Be a Servant Even when your times are challenging, this may be the best time.
- 11. Where to share the Gospel?- Your platform is wherever you are.
- 12. Be eye to eye level with them- People are more receptive if they are not being "looked down" on.
- 13. Declare Power of your soul- Jesus is the winner
- 14. Pray for Divine appointment- Pray for God to lead someone to your path, that you could share the Gospel.
- 15. Satan will tell you... "that you can't share the Gospel, that you don't know enough yet"-- It's true, you can't do it alone, but Jesus can through you.

If you every get a chance to be present at a presentaion from Bob Russler, DO IT, you won't be sorry. This article doesn't reflect half of what he presented, there's so much more.
