Although, there are some "In-App Purchase" options once inside the App. You don't have to purchase anything, once in the app. You will enter your email address and this will be used to send you a notice when it is time for the live service to begin. Once the service has ended, you can not go back to watch the service.

In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven."This biblical charge reminds Christian teachers that their actions and attitudes can illuminate the love of Christ, even in settings where faith cannot be explicitly discussed.

The classroom is your mission field. Being a Christian teacher/administrator in a public school is more than a career—it is a ministry and a mission field. As a teacher or administrator, you have the unique opportunity to shape minds, touch hearts, and inspire lives through Christlike love and service. Every interaction with students and colleagues is an opportunity to reflect God's light and make a lasting impact. By viewing your role as a calling, you can approach each day with purpose, knowing that your work has eternal significance.

1. What is this?



It is called a QR CODE. Meaning it is a shortcut link to a website. In this case it is a link to a website called Rightnow MEDIA.

2. Where do I see this, QR Code, or where do I find it?

It is on the inside of every church bulletin. And this one works too!

3. Why do I want to go to this website called Rightnow Media?

Think of it as a streaming resource, full of 24/7 access to 25,000 + biblical videos for spiritual growth across all ages and groups. All of the media offered on this site is Christian appropriate.

4. How do I use this QR CODE?

It is used with the camera on your smartphone. Simply open your camera app and hold it so that the QR CODE is in your phone screen. .

On your phone screen, you will see a bar line of words pop up on your screen, mine has a yellow bar. Yours may be different. Use your finger to touch the words in the bar line on your screen. The words will be "Rightnow media.org", again this is the name of the website this link is taking you too. Touching it will direct you to the website page.

5. What do I do once I'm on the website?

You will now be on the FSBC's main page and account. Once here, you need to create your own personal sub-account/profile. It is free to church members. The main account with Rightnow Media is with FSBC and they pay for the subscription to this streaming account. It's a free perk from FSBC. Once you create your account/profile, the next time you go to the website, you log in using the username and password that you created for your account.

6. What if I don't have a smartphone? Can I still go to this website?

Yes you can. By way of any computer, in the search bar, enter the website address and hit enter. The website address is: https://app.rightnowmedia.org/en/library/ default Then follow #5 for the set up.
