Grandma Rebecca was arrested, charged and convicted in a six-day federal jury trial in Washington, D.C. for what she says was her obedience to God to carry His presence into the nation's Capitol on January 6, 2021. Rebecca was sentenced to six months house arrest; fined over \$100,000 - the largest federal misdemeanor fine in US history - and was banned from the Internet for being labeled by the DOJ as one of the loudest voices for the January 6th event.

Come hear Rebecca's story, learn about the mission focus of Sarah's Home and Daniel Academy, and enjoy uplifting worship music. Food, fellowship and the Word of God on Saturday morning, September 13th at the Valley Cowboy Church. Please join us.

Sanctification. There must be a clear-cut distinction between Christians and the world. The meshing of the church with the world is one of the great problems facing twentieth century Christianity.




