Stability Hazards

Strong winds could cause wagons to sway precariously or even tip on uneven terrain, posing a danger to both the wagon and its passengers.

Dust and Debris

Winds whipped up dust and debris, leading to poor visibility and discomfort, potentially causing respiratory issues and navigational hurdles.

Cover Damage

Wagon canvas covers risk tearing under windy assault, jeopardizing weather protection and cargo integrity.

Journey Delays

Travel could slow as groups sought shelter or awaited calmer conditions, prolonging their voyages.


