If you missed out this time, know that we missed you too! Next year's festivities beckon, inviting everyone to dive into the sundae fun. See you then!





A cooler, pre-Fall Saturday morning greeted approximately 75 ladies who attended the 5th birthday celebration of the Women's Morning of Inspiration.

The Wednesday Women of the Word (WWOW) Bible Study gals hosted the event at the Valley Cowboy Church on September 13th, and food and fellowship were the first order of business as the guests arrived.

Pastor Craig Ortega of the Full Gospel Church in Rocky Ford, and his Mother, Cindy, provided country gospel worship music to get the morning off on a beautiful "musical" note.

The Mission Focus for the morning event was Sarah's Home/Daniel Academy – a Peyton, Colorado based nonprofit organization that provides rest, refuge, and restoration for teenage girls and boys rescued from sex trafficking. Jillian Winters, the Community Engagement Coordinator for the two facilities, shared with the group the goal of providing a safe haven for the girls at Sarah's Home, and for the boys at Daniel Academy.




